Each kit must include the following items EXACTLY AS REQUESTED. All items MUST be new. There are very strict rules governing product entry into a foreign country. Not adhering to these requirements will delay shipment.

1 hand towel (15x25 to 17x27)

1 washcloth

1 comb, large and sturdy

1 nail file **OR** 1 nail clipper

(NO emery boards or toenail clippers)

1 wrapped bath size bar of soap

1 adult toothbrush in original wrapper 6 adhesive plastic bandages (band-aids)

\$1.00 to purchase toothpaste

Place all items in a 1 gallon re-sealable plastic bag.

A kit costs \$12. You may donate cash if you prefer. Please make checks out to Aldersgate and note "Haiti" in the memo line.

Gifts are tax deductible and 100% will go to help the people of Haiti.
