Many of you know Steve as he has spoken at Aldersgate twice since I have become your pastor.

I have also recently heard that Lambuth University has received a letter of intent to be purchased by a private institution. I know we have Lambuth alumni as part of our congregation and I am sure this news may be upsetting for some.

I ask especially that you keep both of these institutions in your prayers during this time of transition, as they seek to fulfill their mission to equip men and women for their various fields of endeavor.
