

# FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

Former Dean of Memphis Theological Seminary, Donald K. McKim, shares the following:

"What difference does Jesus Christ make? He makes 'preposterous' difference in the life of a Christian."

"The word preposterous is a funny word. It has two parts: a prefix 'pre'- and then the word 'posterous'. Posterous is a Latin word meaning 'coming after' or 'that which comes after'. The prefix pre- means 'before'. So we have a word that literally says: That which comes before (pre-), comes after (posterous). What is before, comes after. Or, we would say 'backwards', 'inverted'. The first is last and the last is first. What is before, comes after: Preposterous! That's why 'preposterous' usually means silly or absurd, 'preposterous' - it's all backward!"

"Now Christianity is a preposterous faith because it asks us actually to live backwards. Or, to put it another way, Christianity asks us to put some things before other things when more naturally, we'd choose to live the other way around. The faith calls us as followers of Jesus Christ to a new lifestyle, a new way of living. It asks us to hold new attitudes. In short, Christianity asks us to live in a way the world may judge to be absurd. Yet all the time, we are really only being truly preposterous."
