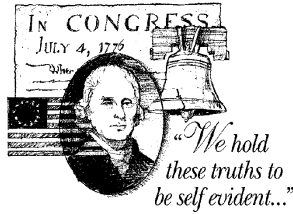

The Koinonia Group will meet at church, instead of Aleda’s, for a special program on July 13, related to our Spiritual Growth Study in August.



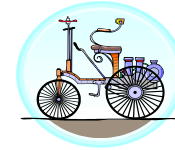
