HOT TIPS for

a COOL SUMMER

Overexposure to ultraviolet radiation from the sun can result in painful sunburn, skin cancer, eye damage and many more health risks. Be "sun wise": do not burn; do not sun tan or bed tan, generously apply sunscreen that provides BOTH UVA and UVB protection with a minimum SPF factor of 15, and wear protective clothing when possible. Seek shade while outdoors and use caution near water and sand, which reflect the damaging UV rays. Remember, children are especially at risk, so keep them protected.
