According to a recent survey almost three-quarters of Americans who haven't darkened the door of a church in the last six months think its "full of hypocrites." and even more of them consider Christianity to be more about organized religion than about loving God and people.

Almost half of those surveyed – 44 percent – agree that "Christians get on my nerves." But the survey of "un-churched" Americans by LifeWay Research also found that 78 percent said they would be willing to listen to someone who wanted to tell them about his or her Christian beliefs.

Never pass up the opportunity to share your faith with someone. As some of us discovered when we studied the parable of the sower during Vacation Bible School, (Matthew 13) we never know the soil of a person's life and how our witness may influence that person coming to know our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.


