FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

When I was as a chemical engineer all the plants I worked at had boilers for generating steam. You would never be able to look into a boiler to tell how much water there was in it, but you would be able to tell how much water the boiler contained by an instrument which is attached to the side. Alongside was a small glass tube which had some fluid in it. If this glass tube was half full of liquid, then there was an indication that the boiler was half full of water; if there is no liquid in the glass, then we understood that there was no water in the boiler. The little glass gauge was the indicator for the large boiler.




