The Perfect Weed Control by Antje Hill

I shook my head in disbelief at the weeds that had managed to come up in our flowerbeds. They were green and disgustingly healthy looking, more so than the flowers we had planted in the spring. I knew these weeds would have to be taken out by the root if we were to be rid of them.

This is not unlike our spiritual life. No matter how God-like we want to be, a little neglect is all it takes for weeds to take root in our life. Less than Christ-like characteristics can creep in slowly with no warning. We don't wake up one morning and decide to be bitter or angry or unforgiving.
