DISCIPLINE FOR DISCIPLES Articles of Religion of the Methodist Church

Article V—Of the Sufficiency of the Holy Scriptures for Salvation

The Holy Scripture containeth all things necessary to salvation; so that whatsoever is not read therein, nor may be proved thereby, is not to be required of any man that it should be believed as an article of faith, or be thought requisite or necessary to salvation. In the name of the Holy Scripture we do understand those canonical books of the Old and New Testament of whose authority was never any doubt in the church. The books of the Old and New Testament, as they are commonly received, we do receive and account canonical. (Paraphrased)
