#### Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia!

What a joyous Easter Sunday celebration we had! And what a welcome relief it was to say and sing Alleluia again, following the more somber and reflective season of Lent, only accentuated by the pathos of Holy Week. We've changed the colors from the purple of Lent, to the black of Good Friday, to splendid white symbolizing the hope of the resurrection, the purity and newness that comes from victory over sin and death.

And now, here we are in the Easter Season, which begins on Easter day and continues for fifty days. The fortieth day of Easter, always a Thursday (May 5, 2016), is Ascension Day, which we will observe on Ascension Sunday, May 8, 2016. The Easter season ends on Pentecost Sunday, May 15, 2016.

The Easter eggs have been collected and found their way into the baskets filled with chocolate candy eggs and bunnies. Pictures in pastel Easter finery have been taken in front of Easter lilies and flowered crosses. Families and friends have gathered at tables for Easter feasts of ham and lamb. Now what? What do we do with the remaining days of the Easter season? How do we live out Easter? How do we live out our faith - our firm belief that on the third day, Jesus rose from the dead?

We are called to use the gifts God has given us in the work of ministry to spread the Good News of the Resurrection in the power of the Holy Spirit and the name of Jesus Christ. Keith Tonkel, (Elder in the Mississippi Conference), calls it 'Practicing Easter'. He got the expression from the title of an article he admits he didn't read, but according to Tonkel, "the title was gift enough". He says: "It's one thing to celebrate Easter, to respect it, even to give some time and energy to worship that day. To 'practice' Easter is something else. This means to live that life we choose. If we've found our own resurrection, then we begin to see it working through us....You have seen and known resurrection, now live as one who practices it... Easter people continue to do just that. Living Easter makes a holiday a way of life."

That's our call. That's how we live out our Easter faith! In the power of the Holy Spirit and the name of Jesus Christ, let us practice Easter in such a way that it becomes a way of life!
