### Pastor's Ponderings "...that they all may be one" John 17:21

The first Sunday in October is designated as World Communion Sunday, a time when we celebrate our oneness in Christ with all our brothers and sisters around the world. Originally called World Wide Communion Sunday, World Communion Sunday is a gift of the Presbyterian Church to the larger ecumenical church. The first celebration occurred at Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, PA, in 1933. It was an attempt to bring churches together in a service of Christian unity.

Celebration of World Wide Communion Sunday was adopted as a denominational practice in the Presbyterian Church (US) in 1936. Although churches in other denominations were invited to celebrate with the Presbyterians from the beginning, it wasn't until 1940, when the Department of Evangelism of the Federal Council of Churches (a predecessor body of the National Council of Churches) promoted extending the celebration to a number of churches around the world, that the practice became widespread. It really caught on during WW II. When the emphasis was on trying to hold the world together, World Wide Communion symbolized the effort to hold things together, in a spiritual sense. It emphasized oneness in the Spirit and the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The key word for World Communion Sunday is communion, or unity. It is a day when we mark the almost universal Christian practice of breaking bread with one another and remembering both the night of Jesus' betrayal, when Jesus instituted what we now call the Lord's Supper, as a lasting remembrance and of Jesus' sacrifice. World Communion Sunday is a time for remembering that around the globe in different languages, with different traditions and customs, and in various forms of liturgy the Lord's Supper is celebrated throughout Christendom.

Sunday, October 4, starting at 10:00am, we'll celebrate World Communion Sunday at Asbury UMC. Following the Communion service, we'll have the Festival of Cultures celebrating the different cultures represented in Aldersgate, Asbury, and El Redentor churches. Come and celebrate!
